We provide toast every morning as the children enter school.

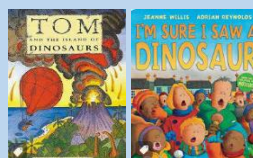
Milk and fruit is provided every day during snack time.

**This term's learning**

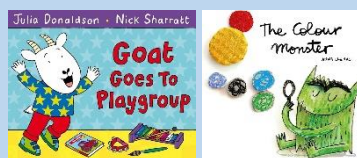
Our topic this half term across Early Years is **All About Me.**



Children in Reception will listen to the following stories and learning will be focused based on the stories below.

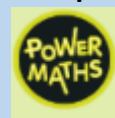


**Children in Nursery will base their learning on the following stories:**

In Reception our maths topics for this half term are:

- Numbers to 5
- Comparing groups within 5
- Shapes 2D/3D

The children have maths every-day. We follow a mastery approach maths scheme.

**Nursery**

In Nursery we will be focussing on:

- Counting songs
- Number recognition to 5
- Introducing one to one correspondence

**Important days of the week**

**Friday** – Home Learning books are sent home from Reception for children to practise saying the sounds learnt during the week and have a go at writing them in the book.

**Wednesday** – Reception children to return Home Learning book so new sounds can be added ready to go home again on the Friday.

Reading books will be sent out later in the half term for both Nursery and Reception.
