#### Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to the start of the new academic year 2023/2024. I hope you have all had the opportunity to have an enjoyable and restful break.

This time last year, we had started to make some significant changes to the structure and organisation of the school. This process has continued throughout the year and especially over the last few months.

I am delighted to say that every classroom in the school is now looking fantastic! The refurbishment/ upgrading programme for the school now provides the children at Salisbury with the high quality, wellresourced learning environment they deserve to be in. We have also added new toilet facilities for our KS1 children and modernised the KS2 toilets so that they are up to standard. Overall, the school is now better equipped and suited to meet the needs of all the children.

We have added some pictures for you to see the changes but if you wanted to drop in and take a look then you are very welcome to do so, as long as it is at a convenient time.

The Early Years Foundation Stage Hub will now be able to accommodate provision for 2 year olds and we aim to get this up and running after half term. Children in Nursery and Reception have been benefitting from the lovely new space for a while now.

Please note the following:

Entrance/Exit points for children

EYFS and Year 1 and Year 2 will enter and exit the building off the small playground

Children in Nursery/Reception will enter and exit through the main entrance to the 'Hub' building

Children in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6 will enter and exit through the main playground entrance – signs have been added to indicate where parents should expect to collect the children at the end of the day

Staff will be present at the gate entrances in the morning and end of the day to help.

It is important that children arrive at school by 8.45am. The gates close at 8.55am so please ensure children are not late.

(Please note Nursery times remain as 8.30am to 11.30am)
