Thank you to everyone who attended the coffee mornings that were organised by Mrs Richards and Miss Jones, I do hope you found these sessions useful and helpful in gaining information around attendance matters. Our aim, as always, is to support children and families in any way that we can. Year 6 have been preparing for their end of Key Stage 2 SATs so are well into their revision programmes. The tests take place in May and the staff and children are working hard.
