





Apply for a primary school place

Apply for a September 2021 start for reception or year 1, or transfer from infant to junior school (year 3).



<u>Apply for a secondary</u> <u>school place</u>

Apply for a september 2022 start if your child is due to transfer to a secondary school (year 7).

Applying for schools outside Walsall


If you live in Walsall but any of your preferred schools are outside Walsall Borough, you can still apply in the same way. Walsall Council runs a co-ordinated admissions scheme with neighbouring councils and ar missions authorities, so you only have to complete one application.

When you need to apply

To apply for a September 2023 place, complete our online application by 31 October 2022. You can use the application portal every day from 8am to 9.30pm.

Apply for a secondary school place

If you miss the closing date of 31 October 2022 your application will be regarded as late. This will reduce your chances of being offered a preferred school.

Benefits of online applications

- Anytime access from Monday 1st September 2025 Friday 31st October 2025 for on-time applications
- Paperless process
- Easy to use, secure and safe system.
- You will receive email notification of your school place offer on 2nd March 2026.
- You can amend your application after it has been submitted up until the closing date of 31st October 2025.

Useful Information

- Ensure that you submit your application by 31st October 2025.
- Do your research on prospective schools and attend open evenings.
- Read the on-line information for parents' booklet on our website <u>School</u> <u>admissions | Walsall Council</u>
- You can list up to 5 schools, we strongly urge you to use all 5
 preferences to maximise the opportunity to be offered a preferred
 school.
- If your preferred schools are oversubscribed, your child will be placed on a waiting list and the LA will allocate a place at the closest school to the child's home address with a vacancy.
- Some schools require supplementary information forms, please check the admission criteria for each school.
- We advise against listing 5 grammar schools this will limit your chances of being offered a preferred school.
- Include at least 1 local school that you feel your child would have qualified for in previous years.

Result of a late application:

It is extremely important that you submit your application by 31 October 2025.

- Late applications are processed after all those received on-time.
- Your child might not be offered a place at any of your preferred schools, even though you may live very close to the school and have other children attending there.
- Your child could be allocated a place at an alternative Walsall school which may not be your most local, or one that you would have chosen.
- It is unlikely that a place would become available at your preferred school from the waiting list.

- You MUST submit your application by 31st October 2025.
- List 5 school preferences on your application.
- Some schools require supplementary information forms – they MUST also be submitted on time, directly to the school.
