English

Reading

Every day, the Year 1 children will be apart of guided reading. During these sessions, your child will take part in a variety of activities, such as: reading with a teacher, completing independent reading activities. comprehension skills and vocabulary / phonics work. This will help to strengthen both their reading skills and their comprehension ability. Your child will be given a book that is suited to their reading ability and will come home with one weekly.

<u>Science</u>

Plant detectives! We will be discovering the parts of different plants and what they need to grow.

<u>Geography</u>

Where I live?

This unit will explore the area around Salisbury Primary School and the difference between physical and human features.

Computing

During computing this half term, Year 1 will be familiarising themselves with Purple Mash, learning how to login safely and how to keep their passwords safe. They will be looking at how to stay safe online and will understand this applies to home computers too.

<u>DT</u>

Houses and homes.

We will be focusing on sharing experiences of our own homes and the shapes and features of houses.

RE

Our RE topic this half term is looking at different celebrations, this includes why they are special, who they are special too, and what happens during these celebrations.

Mathematics

Children will be counting up to 10,

sorting objects into groups and recognising numbers up to 10. They will



then be focussing on addition and subtraction. Finally, before the end of term they will be learning the names and properties of 2D and 3D shapes.
